October 7, 2018 ***“Love Radically!”***

### **Thinking about it:**

What is the craziest thing you have done for someone because you love them?

What is the craziest thing you have heard of someone else doing because they love someone?

We know of things people have done **“for”** others because they love them... and we know of things people have tragically done **“to”** others because they “love” them. (*i.e. harming them because they can't have them*)

Is it truly love that motivates both actions mentioned above?

Why or why not?

### **From Sunday's Message: “Love Radically!”**

We saw how the Lord loves us radically by being “crushed” for our sin to make “intercession” for us... a connection path to relationship with God. We saw how the apostle Paul loved radically when he expressed a willingness to be “cut off” from Christ himself, if it would save others...the Jewish people. (*remember what that would mean for Paul!*) And we saw how we are to love radically by making “room for” or a way for lost sinners to become part of our spiritual family in Christ.

What did Jesus do because he loves us radically?

Isaiah 52:13-15 & Chapter 53

John, chapters 18 & 19

What did the Apostle Paul do because he loved others radically?

II Corinthians 11:16-33

What are we to do because we love others radically?

Matthew 28:18-20

Mark 16:15-16\*

II Corinthians 5:11-21

What are you doing because you love others radically?

***PRAY: Thank God for His radical love that opened the path to relationship with Him! Thank God for the apostle Paul (and others through the years) whose radical love kept the message alive to where you were able to hear it! Give God permission to “radicalize” your love for others and show you how to practice it!***
